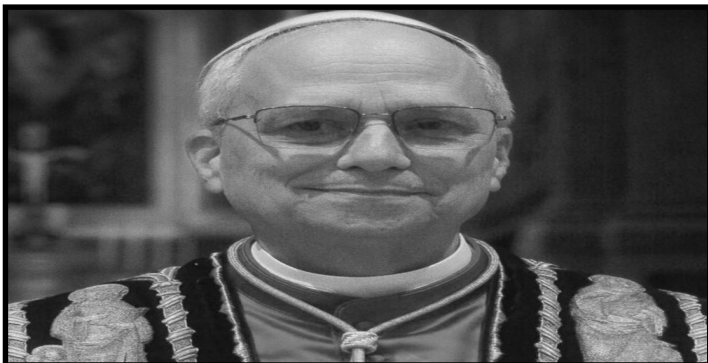

POPE LEO XIV

On Thursday 8 May the Conclave of Cardinals which had begun the previous day decided, on the fourth ballot, that Chicago-born Cardinal Robert Francis Prevost should be the man to lead the Church.

Our new Pope, a member of the Augustinian order, chose the name and title of Leo XIV. Some of his predecessors of the same name are remembered as Popes who unified the Church in their own time (Pope St Leo the Great) and who spoke out about workers' rights and promoted devotion to Our Lady and the Rosary (Pope Leo XIII).

Already Pope Leo XIV has given us a sense of how he thinks and of the direction in which he hopes to guide the world's Catholics during this Holy Year and beyond. We hope and pray he'll be a force for peace, building bridges in our broken world, promoting justice and equality and preaching the gospel, the Good News of the love and mercy of God.

His first words as Pope in public were the first words of the Risen Christ to His disciples: "Peace be with you." On the day of his inauguration (Sunday 18 May) we wish Pope Leo XIV Peace, Love, and the Joy of the Gospel in his ministry to us all.

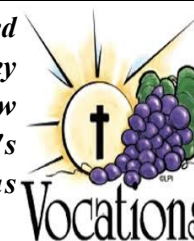
