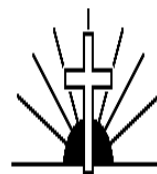

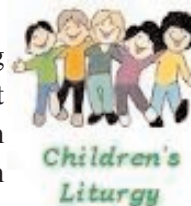
Bethany Bereavement Support
