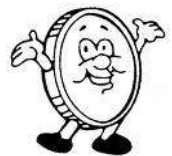

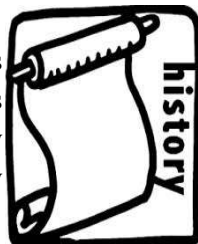
Working in Partnership with St. Mary's College,
