***“Rejoice in hope, be patient in suffering,
persevere in prayer. Romans 12:12***

Why do those people with real, genuine faith seem to be people of peace, people with peace? Because faith in God's unconditional love gives them hope. What is real hope? 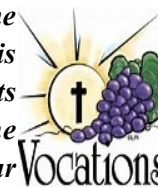

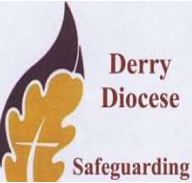
