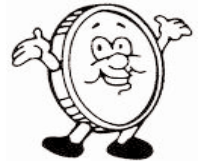

9th WORLD MEETING OF FAMILIES

Pope Francis has decided that the Dublin World Meeting of Families will be held from 22nd to 26th August 2018, and has chosen the theme: "The Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World." *The World Meeting of Families will be organised jointly by the Pontifical Council for the Family and by Archbishop Diarmuid Martin, as bishop of the host diocese. The planning will involve teams of women and men, clergy, religious and lay, from all over Ireland. A Committee of the Irish Bishops' Conference has been set up to oversee fundraising for the event. In preparation for the meeting a programme of pastoral preparation centered on the family will take place across Ireland, especially during 2017. It hoped that alongside the events gestures of solidarity will be fostered, such as for example a Pope Francis Fund for Homelessness.*
