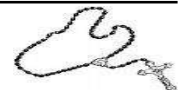

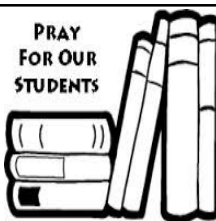

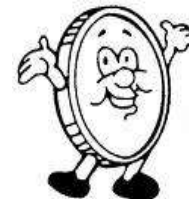
Exams 2018 - Pray for Our Students
