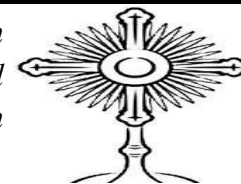

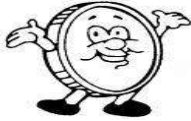


Eucharistic Adoration - Our Parish Day of Eucharistic Adoration will begin on Thursday 14th March from 9.00am - 6.00pm.

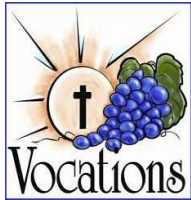
