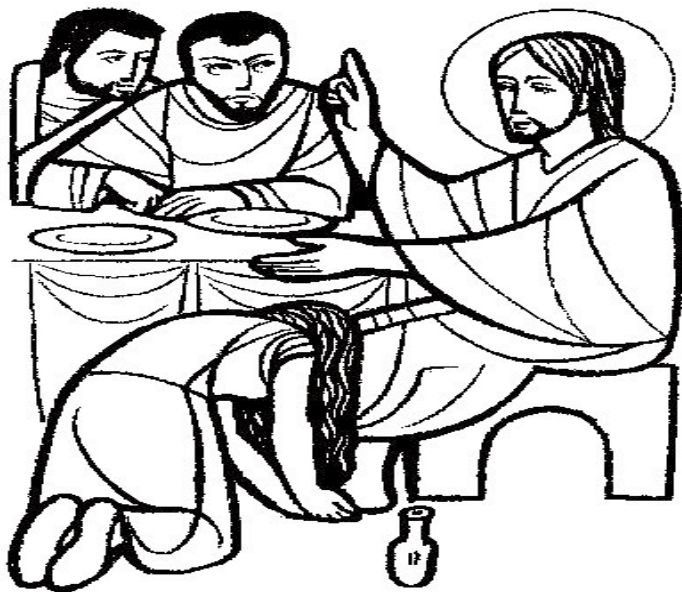

### *The Forgiving Christ*

*The Pharisee said to himself: "If this man were a prophet he would know who this woman is that is touching him and what a bad name she has". Once more we have a beautiful example of how Jesus treats women with gentleness and care. This time, however, we also see how he treats someone who is considered a sinner. All he has for her is compassion and understanding and forgiveness. This was a source of scandal for the people around him. How do we treat one another when someone fails? Very often it is with criticism or anger or condemnation. That is not the way of Jesus. We are called to practice the same qualities of love with one another as Jesus has for the woman in this story. We need to practice gentleness and understanding in the close relationships of marriage and family life. This can be difficult at times. And we need the same qualities within our faith community if we are to be true followers of Christ.*

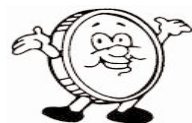
**Car Parking:** Please follow the stewards' instructions and avoid parking along the road, to ensure a free flow of traffic before and after the ceremony.
