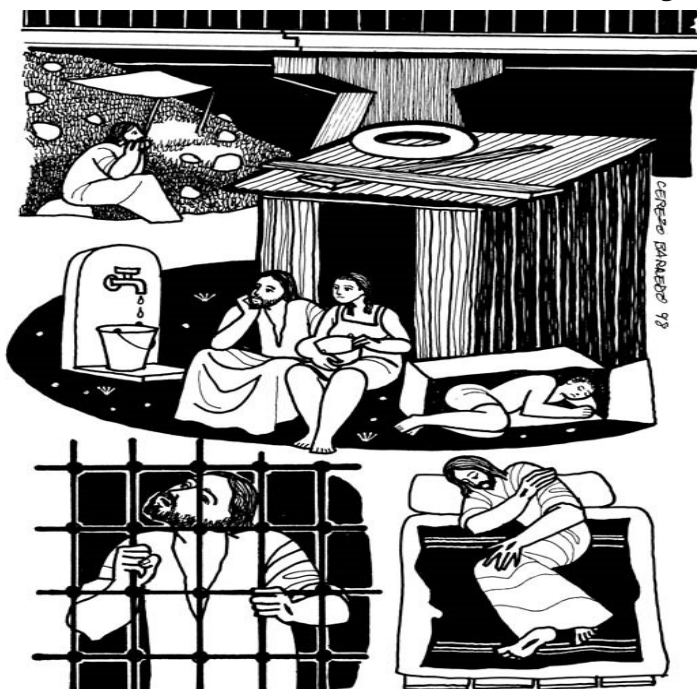

Our Parish day of Prayer takes place next Wednesday 29th November.

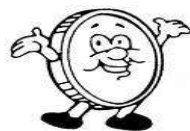


Rosary around the Coast of Ireland for Faith & Life.
