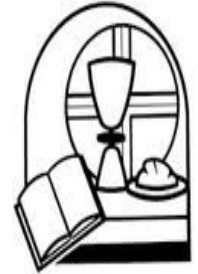

**St. Oliver Plunkett Hall.**

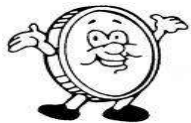
