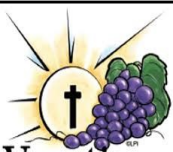

GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY

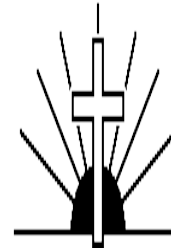
Jesus, the Good Shepherd, the One who knows His sheep and calls us to follow Him, calls Himself the Gate of the Sheepfold. He calls us. He invites us to enter into His life, into the mystery of His merciful love, a love that knows us and wants to protect us and care for us. Jesus wants us to follow Him into the sheepfold that is the Church where we can hear God's Word and receive Him in the Eucharist. 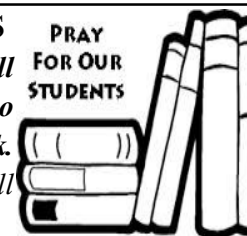
ALL IRELAND ROSARY RALLY 2026
