True humility is about acknowledging God as the source of all life and all goodness and giving praise to God from our hearts. It also teaches us that we have no right to judge anyone else because God alone is our judge and he only sees the goodness in each one. We look at each other and see all that is wrong and we criticise. If we learn to look with the eyes of God we will see the wonder and beauty of each other and learn to praise. This is particularly important for married couples, for families and for the health and happiness of our parish community.

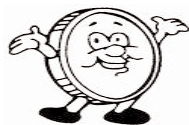
