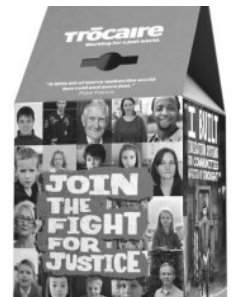
Divine Mercy Novena
