Unfortunately due to the COVID-19 pandemic the Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes has been cancelled for this year.

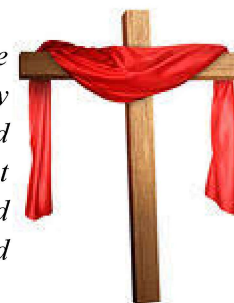
