Pilgrimage to Clonard Novena

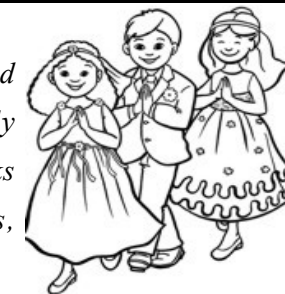

First Holy Communion

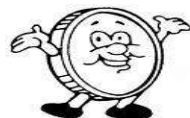
