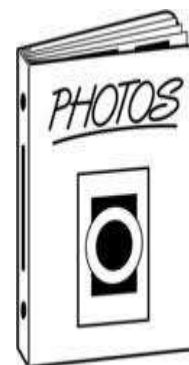


World Meeting of Families - Festival of Families

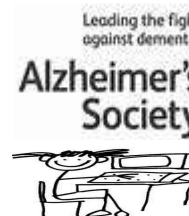
