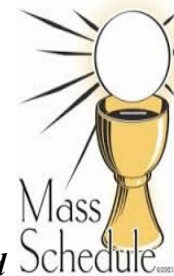

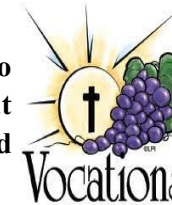

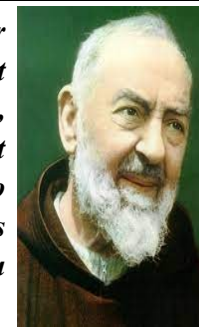


Vocations
