- **Funerals, Weddings, Devotions such as Stations of the Cross and Confessions will continue as normal as will Adoration. It is asked that no more than 100 people** be present at any such event.
All these arrangements are subject to review at short notice.
- **Priests are asked for the time being not to visit Hospitals.** Hospital Chaplains will continue to visit patients, while following hospitals agreed procedures.
- These are difficult measures but are designed to protect the sick, the old and the vulnerable.
- *It is also a time for heightened prayer & watchfulness for those who need our care. We are asked to pray for the Civil & Medical authorities at this difficult time.*

These measures will take effect after St Patrick's Day on Wednesday 18th March.

Masses will be as usual this Weekend 14th/15th March and also on St Patrick's Day

The Church will be open daily for prayer from 9.30am until 6.00pm.
