*When the Lord saw her he felt sorry for her. "Do not cry" he said. We meet Jesus in the Gospel story of this week confronted with a heart-rending scene. 

Collection: An opportunity will be provided for those who wish to make a donation towards the upkeep of the cemetery. Thank you for your co-operation.




