Car Parking: Please follow Stewards' instructions and avoid parking along the road, to ensure a free flow of traffic before & after the ceremony.



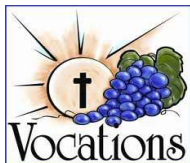
Collection: An opportunity will be provided for those who wish to make a donation towards the upkeep of the cemetery.

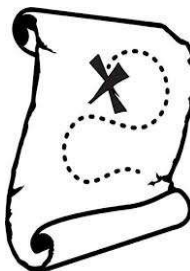

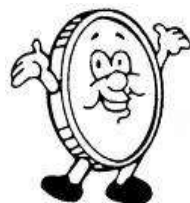
This will be a short walk up and down the Main Street finding answers to clues, followed by tea in the Centre.
