## THIRTEENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR SUNDAY 28 JUNE 2026

At first glance, Jesus' words about loving Him more than family can sound harsh. However, this is not an endorsement of neglecting family. Rather, it is a spiritual principle: when God is the ultimate priority, our love for others becomes purer and more selfless. Discipleship requires a willingness to carry one's cross—enduring hardship and prioritizing God's will above worldly comforts.

You don't need to do something monumental to serve God. Jesus promises that even giving "a cup of cold water" a simple, small act of kindness done in His name—will be deeply noticed and rewarded by the Father.

*In this weekend's gospel Jesus encourages the men He is calling to priesthood not to be afraid to "...take up their cross and follow [Him]..." and promises them that they will find fulfilment and "life" in Him.*

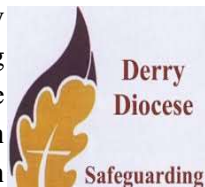
