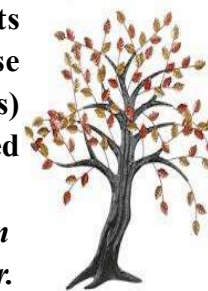

Leaves are available in the baskets on the tables in the Church. Please write the name of your loved one(s) on the leaves and they will be placed on the tree in the Sanctuary.

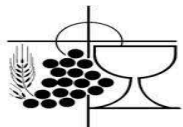
If you take leaves home please return by 12noon on Sunday 11th November.

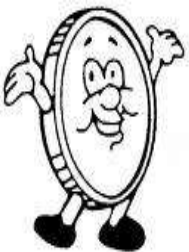
