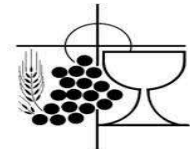

Service for Our Deceased

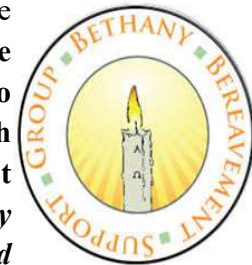

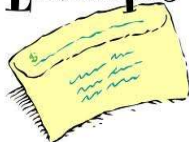
