Having consulted with the Parish Pastoral Councils in both Greenlough and Bellaghy, I have opted for the following schedule of Masses which will come into force on the evening of Saturday 26th November 2022.

Bellaghy: 11.00am

GREENLOUGH

Tuesday: 9.30am; Thursday: 7.30pm

The Weekday Mass timetable may be amended occasionally. Any amendments will be announced in advance in the parish newsletters and/or on the parish websites/social media.

If possible, Month's Mind and First Anniversary Masses may be celebrated at different times, but other anniversaries will be celebrated at the scheduled weekend or weekday Masses.

This new timetable has been arranged in light of recent changes and allows for the possibility that, on occasion, there may be only one priest available to celebrate Mass in our parishes, although this would not be sustainable on a regular basis.

The Pastoral Councils will continue to discuss this aspect of parish life, including arrangements for the time, in the not too distant future, when there will be only one priest serving the people of both Greenlough and Bellaghy, without the generous assistance of the retired priests who are currently in their 80s and are helping whenever they are available to do so.
