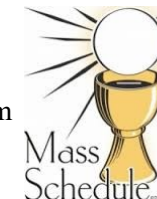

First Confessions

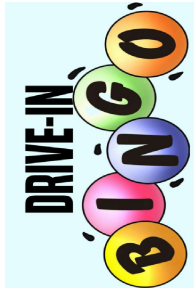

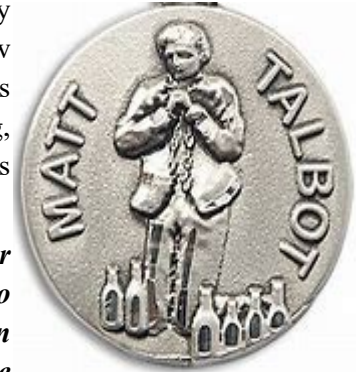
