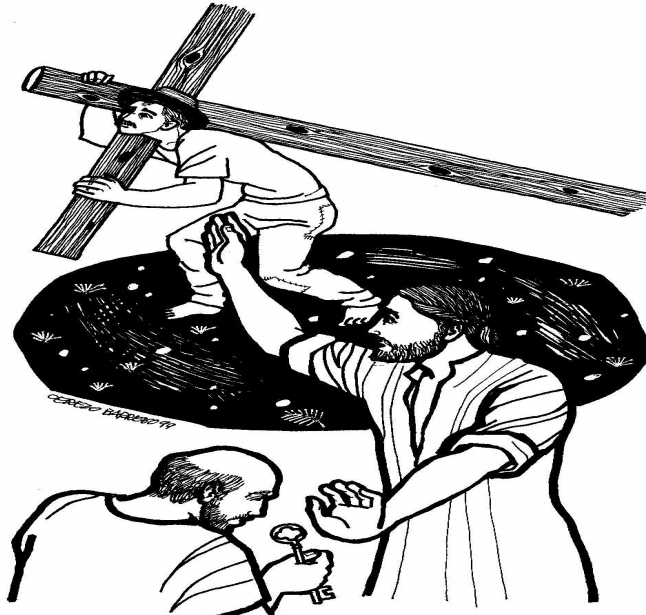

The Triumph of the Cross.

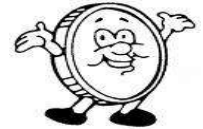
