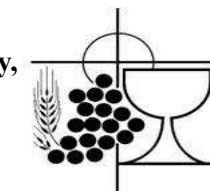

WORLD MISSIONS IRELAND



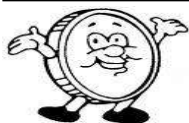

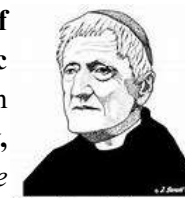
