Blessing of Pets & Animals - Sunday 4th October

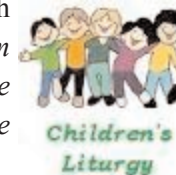
As we celebrate the feast of St. Francis, whose love of animals was so well known, there will be a blessing ceremony of all family pets and animals.



The Blessing will take place in St. Mary's Lavey Car Park at 1.00pm **this Sunday.** Everyone welcome.

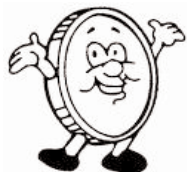
