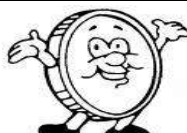

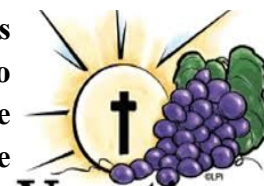
**Our Parish Day of Prayer**
