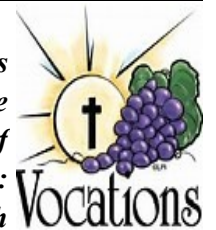

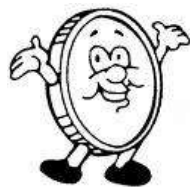
### VOCATIONS

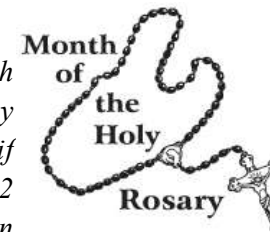
