FACE COVERINGS IN PLACES OF WORSHIP

The NI Executive has agreed a number of relaxations to the Covid -19 restrictions, which came into effect this week - **The requirement for the wearing of face coverings in places of worship, during acts of worship, will be moved from regulations into guidance only.**

Face coverings will still be legally required when entering and exiting the building and will be strongly advised whilst singing or moving around the premises.
