POPE LEO XIV

As I write this piece the Conclave is just about to begin. Maybe by the time you read this the election of our next Pope will already be over, meaning that someone will have received the 90 votes necessary. Whenever that happens, whoever the "successful" candidate is, he needs our prayers.

This weekend we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Easter, known as Vocations Sunday or Good Shepherd Sunday. Our new Pope will be expected to be the Shepherd of the whole world, of all the people of God, both inside and outside the Church.

MARY'S MEALS

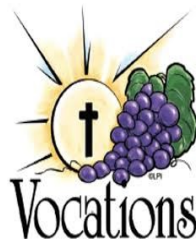
