At the most recent meetings of the Parish Pastoral Councils in Bellaghy and Greenlough it was decided to implement a change in Mass times, beginning on Tuesday 1 July 2025.



Vigil Masses will remain as they are:
Clady, 5:30pm; Bellaghy, 7.00pm.

Sunday: Ballyscullion, 9:45am.

Mass in Greenlough and Bellaghy will be at 11.00am, on alternate Sundays, as follows:

6 July: St Oliver Plunkett Church, Clady, 11.00am;

13 July: St Mary's Church, Bellaghy, 11.00am;

20 July: Clady; 27 July: Bellaghy, and so on...

Sunday Masses will be broadcast from church to church via the webcams. This will mean that those who wish to attend Mass but cannot travel can go to their local church where they can participate in Mass with the advantage of bringing able to receive Holy Communion.

Weekday Masses will be as follow, at 9:30am
Bellaghy, Monday & Wednesday;
Clady, Tuesday & Friday.

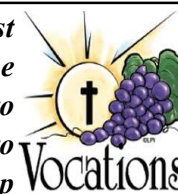

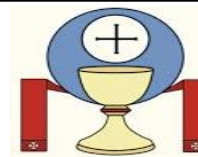
