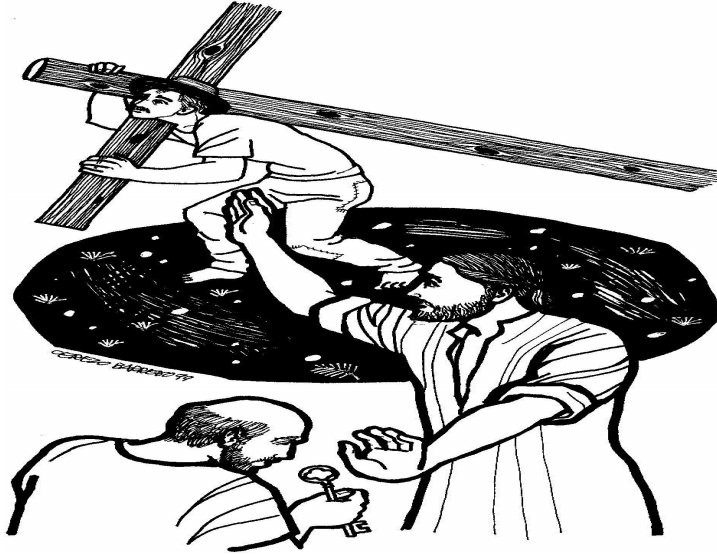

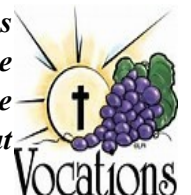
NIE UPDATE - We have been advised
