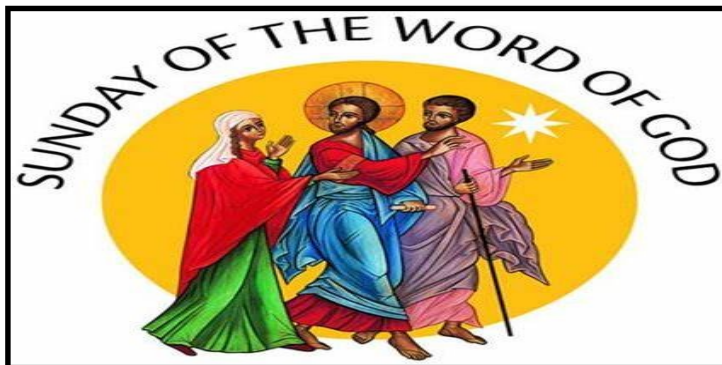

You may have read or heard during the week that the parish of Cappagh (Killyclogher) in this diocese announced last weekend that, due to current pastoral realities, there will no longer be a Sunday Mass in two of their churches.

There is absolutely no intention of doing anything like that in either of the parishes of Greenlough and Bellaghy, or of closing any of our churches.

Admittedly, we have had to reduce the number of Masses each weekend, and the new timetable will begin on 7/8 February.

While the ideal is that people should attend Mass in their local parish this may no longer suit everyone. With that in mind, next weekend we hope to publish the times of Masses in our surrounding parishes.

Following requests from a number of people, the 5:30pm Saturday Mass in Greenlough will be broadcast in St Mary's, Bellaghy, where those attending will be able to receive Holy Communion. If there's a similar interest from Greenlough parishioners it may be possible to broadcast the 11.00am Mass from Bellaghy to St Oliver Plunkett Church.

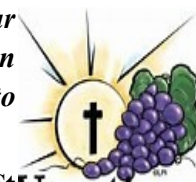


The Parishes of Bellaghy & Greenlough

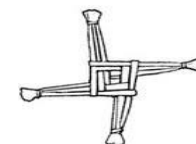
