From 1 September until 4 October (The Feast of St Francis of Assisi) we are in the Season of Creation, an initiative of the late Pope Francis. The theme this year is: "Living Water."

Pope Leo asks us to think about the "deserts inside us, in our hearts" and to pray that the Lord will renew our hearts, moving us from "desert to garden, from division to communion, from violence to peace."

We are invited to pray for all those who will be taking part in World Youth Day in Seoul, South Korea, next year, that they will take courage, and become streams of Living Water, bringing faith, hope, love, and care for creation into the life of the Church and the world.

Let us make Living Water flow.

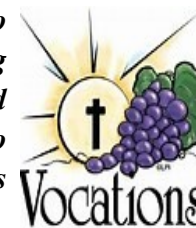

Tuesday Night Rosary continues at 7.30pm in the Church. All Welcome.

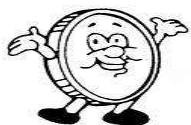

HOST FOR HOSPICE: October is officially Foyle Hospice Coffee Morning Month.

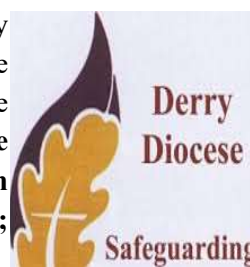
